The Brazelton Touchpoints Approach is an 18-hour interactive seminar designed for people who want to strengthen their work with families by connecting around key points in the development of young children. By helping parents identify and expect bursts and regressions in child behavior (the “touchpoints”), professionals can reduce parental frustration and self-doubt while fostering the parents enjoyment of their child and parenting skills. In the process, the bond between the provider and the family is strengthened.

- Understand the theories and concepts of the Touchpoints Approach, with emphasis on the developmental and relational elements of parent-child-provider relationships, and their practical applications.
- Enhance their delivery of support and care to families by using relationship-building strategies and communication tools based on the Touchpoints Approach.
- Observe and participate in encounters that demonstrate the Touchpoints Approach of collaborative anticipatory guidance.
