The Summer 4-H Intern will increase his/her knowledge of program development, community partnerships, volunteer development and recruitment, group facilitation skills, and careers with the University of Wisconsin Cooperative Extension.

- Provide support for 4-H clubs and summer programs throughout Racine County

- Assist with website updates, brochure development, event registration, and compilation of educational materials for programs
