What makes families strong? Why do some families seem to bounce back after difficult times? Learn how to better support families in times of vulnerability and stress.

This workshop is an introduction to the Protective Factors framework that helps parents to find resources, supports, or coping strategies that allow them to parent effectively, even under stress. Participants will learn to:

1. Understand the five protective factors that help keep families strong and prevent child abuse and neglect.
2. Identify multiple strategies and everyday actions that help families to build those protective factors.
3. Understand the role of culture and the impact of bias.
