




BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- Foxconn generated total annual revenue of \$135 billion and net income of \$4.5 billion in 2016 and was ranked No. 27 on the 2017 Fortune magazine Global 500
 - Fourth-largest technology company in the world
- Foxconn specializes in design, manufacturing and assembly of global computer and high-tech consumer electronics products
- The company has facilities in Asia, Brazil, Europe and Mexico. The Wisconsin facility will be its first significant investment in the U.S.



ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Largest economic development project in Wisconsin history
- 13,000 jobs when campus is complete
- (avg. salary: \$53,000, plus benefits)
- 10,000 direct construction jobs annually over 4-6 years
- \$10 billion investment
- 18:1 return on investment











CONSTRUCTION UNDERWAY

- September 4, 2018: Vertical Construction Begins on Multi-Purpose Building
- Q1/Q2 2019 Additional Buildings
 Begin in Phase 1, Area 1


