

## Racine County 4-H Leaders Association Scholarship Application (2020-2021)



The Racine County 4-H Leaders Association offers scholarship funds annually to deserving Racine County 4-H members. Applicants must be a youth actively enrolled in Racine County 4-H who are current high school seniors or older and who are planning to attend, or those already attending, an accredited vocational/technical school or university for a minimum of a 2-year program. An applicant may **NOT** have previously received this scholarship. This money must be used for tuition or other continuing education expenses.

#### **APPLICATIONS INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Please type your information and follow directions carefully. Handwritten applications will NOT be accepted.
- 2. Completed applications are due by Monday, March 29<sup>th</sup>, by 3:00 p.m.
- 3. The leadership page is worth 60 points. Please be sure to note the following:
  - a. List any offices that you ran for, even if you were not elected.
  - b. Leadership experience could include the following:
    - i. Committees (Club, County, or State)
    - ii. Demonstrations (Project Meeting or Club Meeting)
    - iii. Events you have helped with (Project, Club, or County)
- 4. The General Leader Recommendation page must be filled out, signed, and returned to the Extension Racine County Office by 3:00 p.m. or emailed to beth.mattson@wisc.edu on Monday, March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The recommendation page is to be submitted by the General Leader directly to the Extension Racine County Office. Do NOT include any other letters of recommendation.
- 5. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 6. An applicant may apply as many times as they are eligible, provided they have not previously received a Racine County 4-H Leaders Association Scholarship.

The following will be used to score your application:

60 points - 4-H Leadership

50 points - Teen Leader/Junior Leader Experiences

30 points - Non 4-H Activities

30 points - Discussion Question

10 points - Project Listing

5 points - General Leader Recommendation

15 points - Neatness & Completion of Application; Grammar

200 points = TOTAL
