Early care providers and teachers play an important role in fostering resilience in children. For children experiencing trauma and adversity, the use of trauma-informed strategies can be helpful in understanding the meaning of a child's behavior as well as in finding ways to better meet the needs of the child.

In this 2-part workshop series, participants will add new tools to their tool belt by looking closely at two trauma-informed strategies—regulation and perspective shift. Workshops will include a detailed overview of each strategy and use real life scenarios to generate 10 different ways regulation and perspective shift can be used towards a positive outcome.
