The award recipients are chosen based on the following:

- Complete an **application form** that lists the awards you have won. **5 points**
- Complete a 4-H or FFA **record book**. **30 points**
Submit this year's record book only. Entries will be read and evaluated by a committee consisting of Awards Committee members and Kiwanis Club of Racine members. Criteria for evaluation is based on legibility and neatness of entry and completeness and thoroughness of entry requirements.
- Write an **essay**, not over 200 words long, in response to the questions below. **65 points**
Your essay should be about a project exhibited at the fair this year and another 4-H experience. Do not list ribbons in your essay or you will be deducted points.
 - Why did you participate in this project?
 - What have you learned from this project that you will use in the future?
 - Describe another 4-H experience that you had this year that has taught you something.

Recipients will be guests of the Kiwanis Club of Racine, Inc. at an upcoming meeting. At that time, recipients will receive their awards, which are to be in addition to any premiums awarded by the Racine County Agricultural Society.

Applicants are responsible to submit this form, an essay, and a current year record book (after Club General Leader has reviewed it) to the Extension Racine County office by **Tuesday, October 26th, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.**

Application materials can be dropped off in person at the Extension Racine County office (1072 Milwaukee Avenue, Burlington, WI 53105) on weekdays between 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. or 1:00-4:00 p.m., placed in the green drop box in front of the Extension Racine County Office, or received via USPS mail by the due date and time.

Another option is to drop off materials to the Racine County 4-H Junior Leaders Association meeting (Auditorium, Ives Grove County Office Building, 14200 Washington Avenue, Sturtevant, WI 53177) on Monday, October 25th between 6:45-7:00 p.m. This is the only day and time that materials may be dropped off at the Ives Grove County Office Building.

Late application materials are unable to be accepted. Please be sure that you have won the required ribbons and awards for your program category.

Completeness (*signatures, etc.*) (1 point total)

Total Points – 30 Maximum

ESSAY

Neatness (*legible, organized, typing optional*) (5 points)

WHY you took project? (15 points)

(*The member explains their reason for taking the project.*)

What did you LEARN? (15 points)

(*The member explains what they have learned by taking the project.*)

Story about only ONE project (10 points)

(*-5 points if more than one project noted*)

Paragraph on what TAUGHT you the most (15 points)

(*5 points for stating what the member was taught, 5 points for mentioning use in future, 5 points for being positive*)

Mentions another 4-H experience (5 points)

Any mention of ribbons or more than 200 words (-5 points)

Total Points – 65 Maximum
