



Racine County 4-H Leaders Association Scholarship Application (2021-2022)



The Racine County 4-H Leaders Association offers scholarship funds annually to deserving Racine County 4-H members. Applicants must be a youth actively enrolled in Racine County 4-H who are current high school seniors or older and who are planning to attend, or those already attending, an accredited vocational/technical school or university for a minimum of a 2-year program. An applicant may **NOT** have previously received this scholarship. This money must be used for tuition or other continuing education expenses.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Please type your information and follow directions carefully. Handwritten applications will NOT be accepted.
2. Completed applications are due by **Thursday, March 31st, by 3:00 p.m.**
3. The leadership page is worth 60 points. Please be sure to note the following:
 - a. List any offices that you ran for, even if you were not elected.
 - b. Leadership experience could include the following:
 - i. Committees (Club, County, or State)
 - ii. Demonstrations (Project Meeting or Club Meeting)
 - iii. Events you have helped with (Project, Club, or County)
4. The General Leader Recommendation page must be filled out, signed, and returned to the Extension Racine County Office by 3:00 p.m. or emailed to jen.reese@wisc.edu on Thursday, March 31st, 2022. The recommendation page is to be submitted by the General Leader directly to the Extension Racine County Office. Do NOT include any other letters of recommendation.
5. Late entries will not be accepted.
6. An applicant may apply as many times as they are eligible, provided they have not previously received a Racine County 4-H Leaders Association Scholarship.

The following will be used to score your application:

- 60 points - 4-H Leadership
- 50 points - Teen Leader/Junior Leader Experiences
- 30 points - Non 4-H Activities
- 30 points - Discussion Question
- 10 points - Project Listing
- 5 points - General Leader Recommendation
- 15 points - Neatness, Grammar & Completion of Application
- 200 points = TOTAL
