## Session Descriptions

<u>Youth ages 5-7</u> – \*\*This is the **ONLY** session youth ages 5-7 can sign up for. We will be making simple crafts and also exploring different projects 4-H has to offer.

**<u>Beginning Basketry</u>** – Participants will learn the basics of basket weaving.

**Glass Painting** – Using paints, participants will create handmade art on vases and jars.

**Book Angel** - You will create an angel by folding pages in a book.

<u>Canvas Painting</u> – This session is a step-by-step process of painting on canvas. Participants will learn to layer and work with mixing colors.

<u>Leathercraft</u> – Learn about tools & skills needed to create unique leather projects. You will create a stamped bookmark and a small coin/trinket pouch.

<u>Homemade Cards</u> – Come learn to rubber stamp and use embellishments to create homemade cards.

<u>Flower Art</u> – Participants will be using a needle hoop and floral pieces to make a wall/door decor item.

<u>Origami Dragons Eye</u> – Students will make a large, paper folded, blinkable eye and drawing/shading/blending techniques.

**Cookie Decorating** – Learn the art of frosting cookies using royal icing.

<u>Scroll saw Puzzle</u> – Participants will be selecting a pattern, learn how to transfer it and create a wood puzzle using a scroll saw. Safety & PPE will also be discussed for this event. <u>Bring safety glasses with side shields. Long hair must be tied back during this event.</u> \* 3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> grade participants must have a quardian present during this session.

<u>Sewn Coffee/Cocoa Cozies</u> – Learn to machine and hand sew cozies for your mug. Participants will learn how to work with thread and sewing machines as well as elastics and buttons.

<u>Lithopane Art 3D Printing</u> – This activity is in conjunction with Gateway's Fab Lab and participants will learn the lithopane process on 3D printers. Participants must bring a photo they wish to use (any size/subject will work).

<u>Beginner Card Making</u> – This session covers the art of making homemade cards using stamps and embellishments.

<u>Advanced Card Making</u> – This is a more advanced step in creating beautiful homemade cards with rubber stamps, paper & embellishments. Note- this session is available to participants who have selected to attend beginner card making in conjunction with this session or are confident in stamping skills.

<u>Decorative Wood Pen</u> – This session teaches the art of creating a beautiful wood pen. Safety & PPE discussion will take place as members will be working with woodworking equipment. <u>Bring safety glasses with side shields. Long hair must be tied back during this event.</u>

<u>Melted Cup Ornament</u> – Participants will create custom ornaments by coloring and shrinking their project by melting it.
