An applicant may **NOT** have previously received this scholarship. This money must be used for tuition or other continuing education expenses.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Please type your information and follow directions thoroughly, as you strive to promote yourself to the committee. Handwritten applications will NOT be accepted.
- 2. Completed applications are due by Thursday, March 14th, 2024 by 3:00 p.m.
- 3. The leadership page is worth 60 points.
- 4. The Adult Volunteer Recommendation page is to be submitted directly from the adult volunteer to the Extension Racine County Office. The page must be filled out, signed, and returned to the office or emailed to emily.janes@racinecounty.com by 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 14, 2024. Do NOT include any other letters of recommendation.
- 5. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 6. An applicant may apply as many times as they are eligible, provided they have not previously received a Racine County 4-H Leaders Association Scholarship.


