

Look for next year's opportunity in mid-December. The Wisconsin 4-H Foundation will award more than \$20,000 in scholarships to outstanding Wisconsin 4-H members and alumni pursuing higher education in 2024.

Wisconsin 4-H Foundation scholarships are awarded to students based on demonstrated personal growth through 4-H, development and leadership in 4-H, academic performance and future educational goals.

To be eligible for Wisconsin 4-H Foundation scholarships students must have been a Wisconsin 4-H member for at least three years; should have a grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college or technical school during the 2024-2025 academic school year. Scholarship winners from previous years are not eligible to receive a second 4-H Foundation scholarship.

NATIONAL 4-H CONGRESS

November 28-December 3, 2024

Youth currently enrolled in Grades 9-12 (grades 10-13 for the 2024-25 4-H year)

National 4-H Congress is a five-day Educational Experience held in Atlanta, GA. Congress is the premiere nation-wide event for 4-Hers to network with others from around the United States, Canada, and Puerto Rico. While at Congress, 4-Hers engage in leadership, citizenship, global awareness, and inclusion. Highlights include educational workshops, exploring the city, international events, community service, educational tours, and the National Congress Gala. The cost for this program is estimated to be \$1,500 per participant.

ANIMAL SCIENCE DAYS

Regional animal science educational opportunities are available to Wisconsin 4-H members. Specifically, Area Animal Science Days is a series of day-long events held around the state in June where youth in the beef, dairy, horse, sheep, and swine projects increase their decision-making skills and knowledge of animals through judging and grading experiences.

Events include dairy cattle evaluation; livestock (beef, sheep, swine, & meat goats) evaluation; oral reasons contests for senior members; and dairy showmanship contests. In addition, each site may offer a variety of workshops like poster and photography contests or horse judging activities.

2024 AASD Registration and Information Booklet – Please read through this before you register for the events To be eligible for Area Animal Science Days, team pre-registration must be submitted by **online form here**. by June 3, 2024. In addition, all participants must be a member of a WI 4-H and must be within the division age limits listed in the AASD Registration and Information Booklet listed above.

Registration fees will be \$12.00 per participant and will need to be paid by check on the day of the event. More information on where to send payments is located in the Registration Guide listed below. Contact the State 4-H office for needs-based scholarship options.
