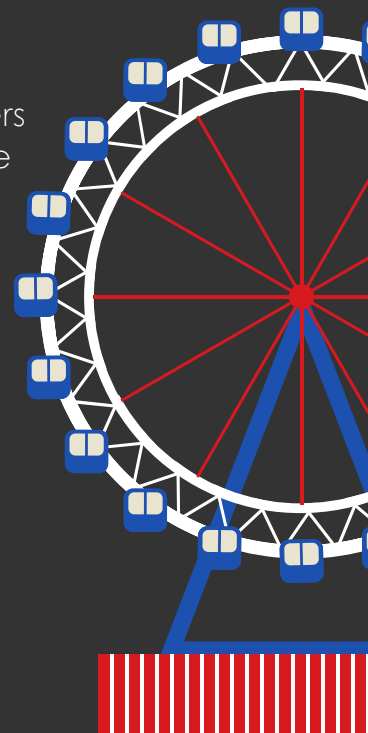
In order to participate:

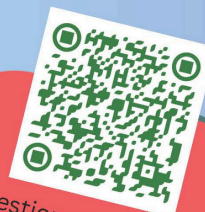

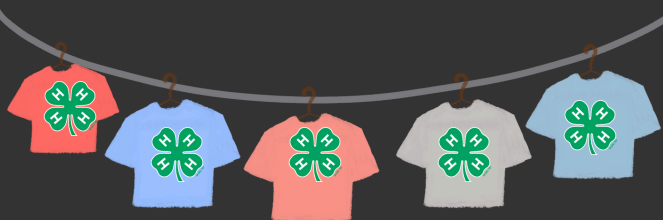
